




AAP4, Polaris Sportsman Offset A-Arms, Installation Instructions


Do not contact store where purchase was made. Dial 812-574-7777 for assistance.

Do not tighten hardware completely unless noted.

- 1. Raise Front of machine off ground, secure with jack stands, and remove Wheels.
- 2. Remove (2) Bolts securing A-Arm to Frame and pull A-Arm away from Frame. See Fig. 1 and Fig. 1a.
- 3. Remove Cotter Pin and Nut that secure Strut to A-Arm. To remove A-Arm from Strut, hit A-Arm with a rubber mallet. See Fig. 2.
- 4. Transfer stock Bushings into new A-Arm.
- 5. Install new A-Arm to Strut and Frame with stock hardware.
- 6. Repeat steps for opposite side.
- 7. Tighten all hardware securely and reinstall Wheels.
