



Liability Statement





Removal: Keep stock hardware and components.

- 1. Raise front of machine off ground, secure with jack stands, remove Wheels, and Shocks from A-Arms.
- 2. Disconnect A-Arms from Knuckles.
- 3. Remove A-Arms from Frame.
- 4. Remove stock Bushings and Sleeves from Upper A-Arms.






2 AA-CA-OUT-HC

Installation: Do not tighten hardware completely unless noted.


- 1. Install Lower A-Arms (H)(K) to Frame; Rear most connections use M10-1.5 x 80mm Lg. FHCS (B) and M10-1.5 Nylock Nuts, Flange (E). Forward most connections use M10-1.5 x 70mm Lg. FHCS (D) and M10-1.5 Nylock Nuts, Flange (E). See Figs. 2 - 2b.
- 2. Reinstall stock Bushings and Sleeves, or SuperATV p/n AAB-CA-001, to Upper A-Arms (G)(J).
- Install to Frame with M10-1.5 x 70mm Lg. FHCS (D) and M10-1.5 Nylock Nuts (E). See Fig. 3. Install optional Steering Stop at this time. See Page 5.
- 3. Reinstall Shocks to Upper A-Arms (G)(J) with M10-1.5 x 65mm Lg. FHCS (C) and M10-1.5 Nylock Nuts, Flange (E). See Fig. 4.
- 4. Install A-Arms (G-K) to Knuckle with stock hardware. See Fig. 5.
- 5. Tighten all hardware completely.


SuperATV recommends using Loc-Tite on Nuts when installing A-Arms to Frame.




