


# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

## FRONT

- 1. Raise front of machine and secure with jack stands. Remove front Wheels.
- 2. Remove top bolt from shock.
- 3. Install Front Lift Bracket (A) to outside of factory mounting bracket. See Fig. 1 and Fig. 1a.
- Front Lift Tabs (B) install to inside of factory mounting bracket. Secure using (1) M10-1.50 x 55mm Lg. HHCS (G), (1) M10 Flat Washer (F), (1) Spacer (E), and (1) M10 Nylock Nut (H). Repeat for opposite side. See Fig. 1 and Fig. 1a.
- Reinstall Shocks into new Lift Brackets and secure using (1) M10-1.50 x 55mm Lg. HHCS (G), (1) M10 Flat Washer (F), and (1) M10 Nylock Nut (H). See Fig. 1 and Fig. 1a.
- 6. Tighten hardware completely and reinstall wheels.

### REAR

- 1. Raise rear of machine and secure with jack stands. Remove rear Wheels.
- 2. Remove top bolt from shock. *Hint: Loosening bottom bolt will help when reinstalling shocks.*
- 3. Install Rear Lift Bracket (D) to outside of factory mounting bracket. See Fig. 3 and Fig. 3a.
- Rear Lift Tabs (C) install to inside of factory mounting bracket. Secure using (1) M10-1.50 x 55mm Lg. HHCS (G), (1) M10 Flat Washer (F), (1) Spacer (E), and (1) M10 Nylock Nut (H). Repeat for opposite side. See Fig. 3 and Fig. 3a.
- Reinstall Shocks into new Lift Brackets and secure using (1) M10-1.50 x 55mm Lg. HHCS (G), (1) M10 Flat Washer (F), and (1) M10 Nylock Nut (H). See Fig. 3 and Fig. 3a.
- 6. Tighten hardware completely and reinstall wheels.
