




FRONT

- 1. Raise front of machine off ground, secure with jack stands, and remove Wheels. Remove Top Shock Bolts. Keep for reuse.
- Locate hole in frame and install (1) each M8-1.25 x 25mm Lg. HHCS (A), M8 Flat Washer (F), and M8-1.25 Nylock Nut (D). See Fig. 1 and Fig. 2.
- Install Front Bracket (H) to machine as shown. Ensure that Washer (F) is *under* Front Bracket (H). Install M10-1.50 x 55mm Lg. HHCS (C) and M10-1.5 Nylock Nut (E). See Fig. 3 and Fig. 3a. *Optional; (2) M10 Flat Washers (G)*.
- 4. Reinstall Shock using stock hardware.
- 5. Tighten hardware completely and repeat steps for opposite side.
- 6. Reinstall Wheels.

REAR

- Raise rear of machine off ground, secure with jack stands, and remove Wheels. Remove Bottom Shock Bolts.
- Install (2) Rear Shock Mount Brackets (J) to A-Arm and secure with M10-1.50 x 55mm Lg. HHCS (C), M10-1.50 Nylock Nut (E), (2) M10 Flat Washers (G),and Spacer (L). Mount to *outside* of stock Bracket on A-Arm. See Fig. 4.
- Reinstall Shock using M10-1.50 x 55mm Lg. HHCS (C), M10-1.50 Nylock Nut (E), and (2) M10 Flat Washers (G).
- Install Sway Bar Spacer (K), under Sway Bar Mount, using (2) M8-1.25 x 35mm Lg. HHCS (B), M8 Flat Washers (F), and M8-1.25 Nylock Nuts (D). See Fig. 5.
- 5. Tighten *all* hardware completely and repeat steps for opposite side.
- 6. Reinstall Wheels.
